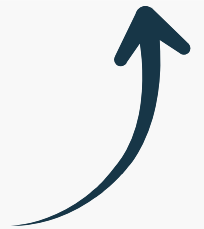
What's your favorite club in the bag? I would have to say my driver. In the years I tagged along it was the club I would always choose to hit. Archie likes his pitching wedge.

Course Superintendent & General Manager

It is always an exciting time when I get to write for the newsletter, especially as spring approaches. Lately, I have been reflecting on how quickly time seems to move; it feels like only yesterday we were closing for the winter, and now it is already March and we are ready to get back on the course.

Before we look ahead, I want to thank everyone for making our "slow season" so vibrant. From packed social events to the many hours spent in the simulator, your support has made my first four months in this role incredibly enjoyable. It truly doesn't feel like work when you love what you do.

I also want to extend a huge thank you to my staff. Their hard work is the reason we are successfully bringing beauty and life back to the club. We have already removed 24 dead ash trees—a major feat given the weather challenges. By being selective with our timing to protect the turf, the crew has kept the course in impeccable condition. I've heard many compliments that the course doesn't even look like it's in winter dormancy; we are definitely ahead of the curve as we enter spring. Special thanks also to the pro shop team for their tremendous support in organizing our winter events and preparing for the busy season ahead.

To improve your experience, I recently attended training for Golf Genius, a software promoted by the Missouri Golf Association. This platform will streamline handicaps, scoring, and communication for all leagues and tournaments. I will be reaching out to league participants regarding this platform very soon.

Course Updates & Projects

- **Beautification:** I am partnering with the Eagle Scouts to build flower beds along the entrance walkway. I will also be planting wildflowers in the "no-mow" rough areas.
- **Water Features:** On hole 10, we are finishing a wider bridge to establish a true water hazard. On hole 15, the pond feature behind the hole 4 green will be restored to include a waterfall.
- **Turf Management:** The bluegrass we planted has germinated well. Our battle against crabgrass begins around March 15 with our first pre-emergent and fertilizer application. Please note that greens will be aerated and sanded during the second week of April to ensure long-term health.
- **Tree Replacement Drive:** To replace the lost ash trees, I have personally purchased three 7-foot trees (Sunset Maple, Blue Spruce, and Sycamore) to begin a replacement drive. If you would like to donate a tree in your honor or as a memorial, please contact me at the club for details.

It's golfing time! I am committed to giving this club my all and challenging my staff to match that energy for your benefit. Thank you for your continued support and encouragement. If there is ever anything you need, please don't hesitate to reach out.
