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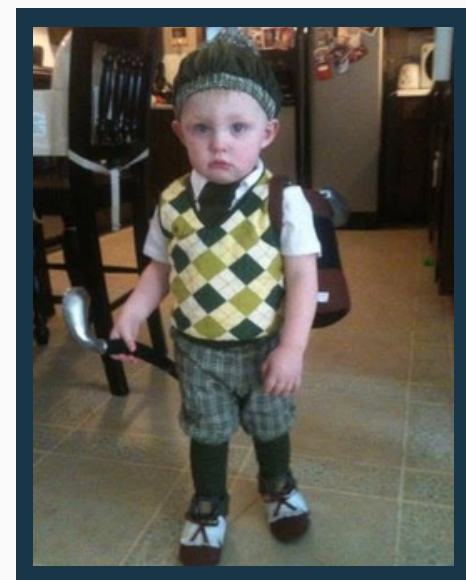
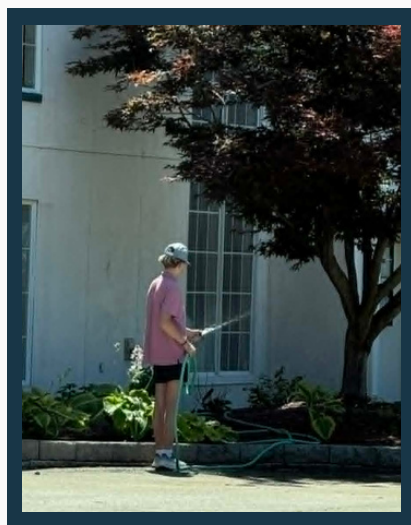
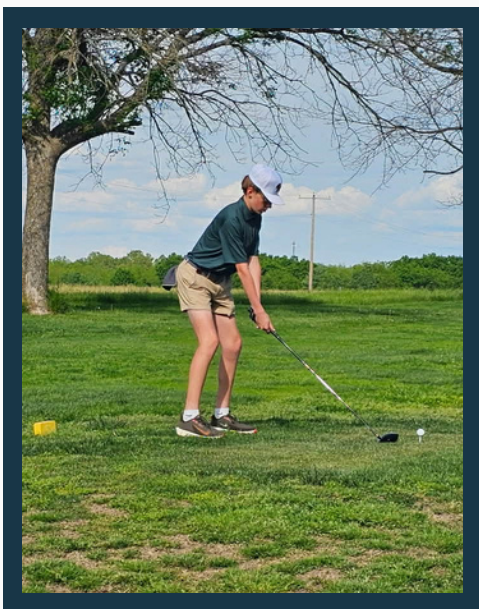

Even though Mother Nature wasn't always on our side and we lost many golf days to rain, you still showed up whenever you could. Because of your support, all four of our June tournaments were a success. A special thank-you goes out to all of our tournament organizers. I truly appreciate your patience, dedication, and the countless hours you invest, not just on tournament day, but in the weeks leading up to each event.
